MiniBoss Project and Child Safety Passport

A clear overview for children, parents and partners

MiniBoss helps a child move from an idea to real action: trying, creating, helping and seeing the result of their work. This document describes the current project direction, the child's journey and the safety principles.

STATUS

MiniBoss is in development. This passport records the approved direction; it is not a legal certificate for a finished service or a promise of investment.

What is MiniBoss?

MiniBoss is a digital learning and project environment in development. Its playful world helps a child understand that growth comes from real action, not from a purchased badge or an automatic reward.

What a child does in MiniBoss

- notices a problem or opportunity and shapes an idea;
- takes a small, age-appropriate and safe first step;
- creates a project and learns through testing and improvement;
- sees who or what benefits from the action;
- presents the result while keeping authorship.

What MiniBoss does not promise

- ready-made success, an automatic reward or guaranteed funding;
- an artificial assistant that thinks or decides for the child;
- financial decisions or contacts without adult control;
- the purchase of growth through money, points or status.

Roles

Child	remains the author of the idea and project and makes age-appropriate choices.
Parent or guardian	gives consent, manages access and takes part in every real-world decision.
MiniBoss	provides a safe journey, clear boundaries and a verifiable technical environment.
Partner or investor	may hear a presentation and make a separate adult-led decision.

The child's six-stage journey

Each stage clearly shows the child what has been done and what comes next. The order cannot be bypassed invisibly.

1**Idea**

The child notices something they want to create, improve or do for others.

2**First step**

A big thought becomes one small action that can genuinely begin now.

3**Project**

The child plans, tests, asks for help and improves the solution.

4**Positive impact**

The child understands who or what genuinely benefits from the action.

5**Result**

The finished work and lessons are described honestly, even when not everything worked.

6**Project Square**

The child can safely present the project to real entrepreneurs and investors.

Core rule

A child's growth cannot be bought. Badges, leaves and achievements may reflect real action already taken, but they cannot replace it.

Project Square and a real opportunity



At the end of the journey, a child may reach Project Square - a place where the project can become visible to real entrepreneurs and investors.

A real opportunity, not a promised outcome

A presentation may open a conversation, mentoring or a possible investment. It does not mean or guarantee investment, funding or business success. Every real agreement and financial decision must involve adults and follow a separate process.

The child remains the author

MiniBoss, Emilia and Api do not take ownership of the child's idea or decide for the child. The child receives support for thinking and presenting, while their voice and contribution remain visible.

Parent control

A parent or guardian manages consent, the account, visibility and real-world contacts. A child is not given independent authority to enter investment or other financial agreements.

Child safety and data principles

The following is a framework of project requirements and checks. It does not claim that every future feature is already complete and is not a legal compliance certificate.

Child's interests first

The experience must be age-appropriate and calm, without pressure, manipulation or hidden selling.

Parent consent and control

The parent manages access, visibility and real-world contacts and can end participation.

Data minimisation

Only data needed for the service should be collected, avoiding unnecessary sensitive information.

Restricted access

Roles must be separated and access to child data checked on the server side.

Reviewable decisions

Important actions must be traceable, reviewable and protected from repetition or unauthorised use.

Safe communication

Contact with real partners or investors requires adult control and moderation rules before launch.

Honest status

Safety is not one finished button. It is built step by step through architecture, permissions, tests, audit, content and human responsibility. A separate legal and security review is required before real contacts or payments are enabled.

Languages, accessibility and project status

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Accessibility requirements

- keyboard operation and a clearly visible focus;
- structure and labels that make sense to a screen reader;
- respect for the reduced-motion preference;
- mandatory subtitles and navigation not dependent on imagery alone;
- readable contrast and responsive views for phone, tablet and computer.

Development status on 26.07.2026

- this is project passport version 1.0;
- the public presentation and Chapter 1 prototypes are in development;
- visuals and presentation elements are replaceable and are not final product art;
- real Project Square contacts and the investment process are not launched by this passport;
- every material change requires a new review and document version.
